To qualify for the College Internship Program, you must be a current student who has autism spectrum disorder. We will assist you with resume writing, interview skills, finding the internship, and offer support and guidance throughout the duration of your internship. Internships can start and end at any time and are available for Fall 2026, Spring 2027, and Summer 2027. **They will work with you to find an internship placement in Terre Haute or close to your home in the summer. Also, Easterseals Crossroads pays the student for their internship!**
